The Festival is highlighted by many magnificently decorated trees sponsored by local businesses, organizations and individuals. The TREE OF LIGHTS is the largest tree at the Festival.

Q WHAT IS THE TREE OF LIGHTS?

A The TREE OF LIGHTS, a highlight of the annual Festival of Trees, is a spectacular fifteen-foot holiday tree adorned with hundreds of twinkling lights and candles. Every light and candle represents a thoughtful donation made in memory of a loved one or in the name of someone special - anyone you want to honor during this holiday season. Each light represents a \$5 donation; each candle represents a \$25 contribution.

Q HOW IS MY CONTRIBUTION USED?
